What are Apprenticeships?

An apprenticeship is a real job with training so you can earn while you learn. As employees, apprentices earn a wage and work alongside experienced staff to gain job-specific skills. Off the job, usually on a day-release basis, apprentices receive training to work towards nationally recognised qualifications. They take between one and four years to complete and cover over 1,500 job roles in a wide range of industries.

Who are they for?

Apprenticeships are open to all age groups above 16 years-old whether you are just leaving school, have been working for years or are seeking to start a new career. There may be different entry requirements depending on the Apprenticeship and the industry sector. However competition for places with employers can be fierce, so you will need to show that you are committed, and aware of your responsibilities to both yourself and the company who would employ you.

Eligibility

You need to live in England, over 16 years old and not in full-time education. There is a requirement that everyone achieves Maths & English at Level 2 (grade C or above) as part of an apprenticeship program so candidates must hold, or have the ability to achieve this. If you already have a Level 3 qualification you may be ineligible for apprenticeship funding. If over 24 years old you will not be eligible for the Age Grant (please see <https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/apprenticeship-grant-training-organisations-fact-sheet>)

Training

Apprenticeships aren't just about getting a job; it's all about making sure you get the skills and training that you'll need to succeed in the world of work. During your apprenticeship you'll essentially be studying for qualifications whilst working. That means you'll be splitting your time between work and college: studying with a learning provider to gain your qualifications, whilst gaining practical experience as you work for a company. Apprenticeships are designed with the help of the employers in the industry, so they offer a structured programme that takes you through the skills you need to do a job well. There are targets and checks to make sure that your employer is supporting you and you are making progress.

When will my training start?

Apprenticeships are available all year round. However, when you begin the work-based training will depend on your chosen employer. Unlike university, the hardest part is securing a position with an employer rather than with your learning provider.

How long will my apprenticeship training last?

Apprenticeship training can last between one and four years. If you start on an apprenticeship, most of the training will take place on-the-job, i.e. at the company which is employing you. You'll be working at least 30 hours a week for the company. The rest of your training will be done at a local college or training provider.

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Consequently, you might be spending two days a week at college and three days in the office or workshop. Alternatively, you might only go to college once a fortnight (or maybe even less). Some employers use a 'block training' approach, concentrating the required off-the-job training into weekly or fortnightly slots across the year

What Types of Apprenticeship are there?

Levels:

- 1 - *Intermediate Level Apprenticeships* -Apprentices work towards work-based learning qualifications such as a Level 2 Competence Qualification, Functional Skills and, in most cases, a relevant knowledge-based qualification.
- 2 - *Advanced Level Apprenticeships* -Apprentices work towards work-based learning such as a Level 3 Competence Qualification, Functional Skills and, in most cases, a relevant knowledge based qualification.
- 3 - *Higher Apprenticeships* - Apprentices work towards work-based learning qualifications such as a Level 4 or 5 Competence Qualification, Functional Skills and, in some cases, a knowledge-based qualification such as a Foundation Degree.

Apprenticeship Wage

The apprenticeship minimum wage applies to all 16-18-year-old apprentices and those aged 19 and over in the first year of their apprenticeship. Some employers can pay more than the minimum wage. On average, apprentices tend to earn around £170 a week; although some earn less and others earn more. Also, after the first year of the apprenticeship, people who are aged 19 and over must get paid the full National Minimum Wage for their age group.

Traineeships

Traineeships prepare you to become 'work ready'. They provide you with essential work preparation training, Maths & English (if needed) and work experience needed to compete successfully for jobs, including Apprenticeships, or to progress to further learning. You can do a traineeship in just about any workplace, for example in a shop, a fast food outlet or office.

Where to start with an apprenticeship or traineeship

Apprenticeships/traineeships are a great way to start a career. First, decide on what Industry Sector or job role you are interested in? If undecided ask friends, relatives and teachers what they think you're good at – where do they think your skills lie? And explore career areas with these.

How to find apprenticeships /Traineeships

Once decided on your Industry Sector you find out more information on apprenticeships and traineeships by visiting the GOV.UK website. Browse by industry sector, region of job role, to find one that is perfect for you.

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Just like job hunting there are different ways to search for apprenticeships. Use the internet and local newspapers

- Look at College or Training provider websites
- Employer websites – sometimes employers advertise on their own website
- Approach an employer

Note: If considering an apprenticeship you may have to find your own employer. For information on local providers look on www.tvwbl.net

To search and apply

Follow these easy steps:

1. Searching. Go to GOV.UK and search 'Find an apprenticeship' for traineeships go to 'Find a Traineeship' and click on the 'Search' link. You can search by keyword (job title, employer or reference number), by location (postcode, town or city), apprenticeship level, or category to suit your criteria.

2. Create an account. Before applying for a vacancy you will need to sign in (if you already have an account) or create a new account. It's easy to register. To set up your account you will need an active email address and a password. Your password should be something you can remember and consist of upper and lowercase letters, a number and at least 8 characters. Once your account is set up you will use the same email address and password to log in to both services.

3. Account activation. When you register for the first time you will receive a confirmation email through your registered email address, which will contain a 6-character activation code. Put this activation code into the relevant box to activate your account.

4. Found a position? Once you have found the position you want applying is actually pretty straightforward. To start with, you'll usually have to fill out an application form or send a CV and cover letter to the company. Most employers will tell you what you need to do on the apprenticeship vacancy posting, but if they only provide an email, you can presume that they expect you to send in a cover letter and CV.

This is the first round of applications. If they like what they see, they'll usually invite you to a face-to-face interview, telephone interview or assessment day. Alternatively, they might ask you to complete some online tests. The application process varies from company to company. For some apprenticeships, you'll simply be required to send in your cover letter and CV and then attend an interview. Other companies, however, may want you to complete an online application form, attend group interviews and assessment days.

Higher and degree apprenticeships are available If you have achieved 5 good GCSES (grades A*-C) and good post 16 results at Level 3 (A levels, BTECs, Advanced Apprenticeship, etc.) you might be interested in looking at a Higher Apprenticeship.

A Higher Apprenticeship is similar to other apprenticeships; it gives you the chance to build up practical work experience while progressing academically up to a higher education level, all whilst being paid a decent salary. Higher Apprenticeships offer existing apprentices, employees and school/college leavers a different route to traditional university study.

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Accountancy

Apprentices who qualify as accounting technicians might work as accounts assistants, credit control clerks, accounts clerks, or finance assistants, all helping accountants to keep financial records and prepare accounts.

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Farrier

A farrier should not be confused with a blacksmith. A farrier works with horses but needs training in blacksmithing in order to make the shoe properly. A blacksmith works with iron and may never have any contact with horses. Only a farrier is permitted to shoe horses. Roughly 100 apprentices are taken on in the industry every year, and competition for places is quite strong.

There is only one way of becoming a farrier and that is to complete the recognised Farriery Apprenticeship through the National Farriery Training Agency (NFTA). The apprenticeship usually lasts four years and two months - working for an Approved Training Farrier and undertaking block release training and assessment to achieve the Level 3 Diploma in Farriery (work-based), in preparation to undertake the Worshipful Company of Farriers (WCF) Diploma in Farriery. The NPTC Level 2 certificate in Forge work is a pre-requisite for the Farriery apprenticeship
